1. Local 1099, of the International Association of Fire Fighters, may conduct appropriate and proper union affairs, including holding membership meetings, on fire department property, providing the conduct of such union affairs does not interfere with fire department operations.
2. The Grand Forks Fire Department Relief Association, may conduct appropriate and proper affairs, including holding membership meetings, on fire department property, providing the conduct of such affairs does not interfere with fire department operations.
3. Each of these organizations may maintain a bulletin board at Central Fire Station with the permission of the Fire Chief or his designee. Each of these organizations may also utilize Fire Programs and/or the "white boards" in the stations to announce meetings or other appropriate material. All postings, to any of these media, will comply with departmental and city policies.
4. SOPs governing the use of tobacco, controlled substances and alcohol shall be adhered to during the conducting of any organizations affairs on departmental property.
5. The department recommends that these organizations make use of their Sergeant-at-Arms in order to ensure that this SOP is complied with.
6. The Organizational Officers are to be held responsible for the conduct of their membership while in or on departmental facilities.
